Giro d'Italia, Vuelta a España and more

From the great second place of yesterday at La Flèche Wallonne of Benoît Cosnefroy (ALM, in the picture), October 2020 will be rich of cycling races: Giro d'Italia starts from Saturday 3rd, Liège-Bastogne-Liège is planned for Sunday 4th, Gent-Wevelgem for 11th, Tour des Flandres for 18th. Last Grand Tour of the season, Vuelta a España, will start on the 20th, and last classic monument, Paris-Roubaix, will take place on 25th.





With Romain Bardet recovering from Tour de France crash, for Giro d'Italia team AG2R LA MONDIALE will count on Tony Gallopin, aiming to conquer a win, to complete all Grand Tour victories. Italian Andrea Vendrame will be attacking in pouncher stages, while young climbers Jaakko Hanninen and Aurélien Paret-Peintre debut on a three week race.

Alpine ski World cup to kick off

The 2020/2021 FIS World cup season is kicking off on October 17th from Soelden, Austria, where Alexis Pinturault (FRA) and Alice Robinson (NZE, in the picture, with at her left Tessa Worley) will defend their 2019 titles in the giant slalom races.
